NIP - Natura 2000 Integration Project - Collecting new inventory data – Lepidoptera

Working on 124 selected 10x10 km square grid cells 3x a year for 2 years.

Grid cells selection (topography, habitat type and accessibility, priority species, minefields, previous knowledge...)

Methodology (transect walks & moth traps)

Plan 62 gridcells each year For 2014 – Continental area 8 people Hopefully – permanent transects





813 sp 20 000 records

- Made only for Lycaena dispar & Coenonympha oedippus
- Coenonympha oedippus has 8 Natura 2000 sites in the Proposal – the Managment plan has been made
