




The eBMS data model



The eBMS in numbers (1990 - 2020) eBMS v4.2

- Thousands of volunteers = high frequency of data
- 15 million counts (44 years)
- BMS grows in Europe: total 28 BMS in 23 countries
- ▶ 5,695,475 observations
- 991,225 visits
- 12,281transects
- ▶ 17,600 km of transects
- 324 registered butterfly species








Transects with at least 5 years sampled after 2000




NATURA 2000 1,907 transects

649 transects






NATURA 2000 (Habitat Directive)

1,433 transects








