

Overview of data, Spain

Records are concentrated in two areas. 29% of records come from a single recorder: Demetrio Vidal.

Most people from Spain, but also some foreign visitors (11% recorders).

- 31,889 butterflies & dragonflies,
- 176 Butterfly species
- 64 recorders
- 31 rare & endemic species (3,298 specimens)

Applicability of 15 minute counts

- ▶ Records in hard-to-reach areas
- ▶ Monitoring endangered or protected species
- ▶ Butterfly samples in specific habitat types
- ▶ Occasional data



Records in hard-to-reach areas

- ▶ High mountain areas
- ▶ Steppes or semi-deserts
- ▶ Islands (i.e., Macaronesian Is.)
- ▶ Areas with limited access



Monitoring endangered or protected species

- We can track the abundance of endangered or rare Butterfly species in particular habitats
- We can count single species or characterize the entire butterfly community

Parnassius nebrodensis (mnemosyne) & *Lycaena helle* have not been recorded with these methods


- ▶ Target species: *Lopinga achine*, *Parnassius apollo*, *Phengaris arion*, *Phengaris nausithous* & *Euphydryas aurinia*
- ▶ 195 tracks
- ▶ 7,612 butterflies counted
- ▶ 118 species recorded
- ▶ 368 records of target species



- ▶ Inventories in protected areas
- ▶ Butterfly data for Impact Assessment studies
- ▶ Studies of target species in particular hábitats. Example: apolo Butterfly in Sierra de Guadarrama National Park (Central Spain)

Compilation of occasional data

- ▶ Holiday trips & travel
- ▶ Record unusual abundances of species
- ▶ Recording the presence of interesting species
